

After passing the MAFP/FRACGP exams

What next?

MAFP (Member, Academy of Family Physicians)

In order to be awarded the Member of the Academy of Family Physicians of Malaysia, MAFP, the candidate has to be a life member of the Academy of Family Physicians of Malaysia. The fee for life membership is RM4,000.00. The Award will be given during the next Convocation Ceremony.

FRACGP (Fellow, RACGP)

Please refer to the guideline "Applying for Fellowship of RACGP". **Please note that successful candidates from ATFM batch intake 2019 onwards will be awarded the icFRACGP award. The criteria remain the same as for FRACGP award.**

National Specialist Register Malaysia (NSR)

The Conjoint MAFP/FRACGP **[MAFP/icFRACGP for ATFM intake 2019 onwards]** Conjoint Exam Qualification is recognized by the Ministry of Health as a Specialist in Family Medicine. All non-MOH candidates must undergo a credentialing process of 18 months (which will be reduced to 12 months for applicants starting in January 2017) *. Applicants will need to fulfill a part time attachment (one day in a week) at a MOH Klinik Kesihatan supervised by a Family Medicine Specialist chosen from a list provided, with a Log Book to be filled up. Application can be made as soon as passing the Conjoint Examinations using the Examination results letter but an applicant must present BOTH certificates of MAFP and FRACGP/**icFRACGP** to the NSR with the completed logbook to finally fulfill the requirements before being registered as a Specialist by the NSR. Having the MAFP alone is currently not sufficient to be recognized by the NSR. The committee meets every three months to vet applications. *Please see Criteria for NSR registration for Family Medicine at NSR website. MOH doctors with MAFP/FRACGP qualifications please refer to KKM gazettelement requirements instead before applying for NSR.

Family Medicine Teacher for AFPM

Members who have passed and are looking forward to help contribute to the Academy are encouraged to apply to become mentors. It is a part time job. Mentors are given 2-5 mentees to help facilitate learning in the ATFM Program towards the Conjoint examination. Mentor sessions are only once a month for each of the 12 modules.

Mentors who have FRACGP and have had 2 years of mentoring experience with a good track record, will be appointed as Trainee Examiners.

Certificate Course in Teaching Family Medicine (CCTFM)

Mentors are also encouraged to enroll into the Certificate Course in Teaching Family Medicine (CCTFM) conducted by the Chapter of Teachers of AFPM. Interested candidates can apply at the Academy. This is a one-year course consisting of three modules. The course fees are RM4000, GST applicable. The fees are fully borne by the Academy with the provision of a service bond of 5 years as an AFPM Teacher.
