



INTRODUCTION

This is a practical course for the general practitioner designed to enhance Orthopaedics skills in a primary care setting.

This course gives a practical approach to the management of common orthopaedic disorders seen at the General practitioner's Office. The course also offers a hands on training to develop skills to address some of these conditions.
